The oelhoa.org website “went live” on February 21, 2007 and has been slowly evolving since then into what is hoped to be a very useful resource for the home owners in the Olde England Lake subdivision. The oelhoa.org website’s **Home Page** has important news and announcements for the residents of our community. These announcements also may include events occurring outside of our neighborhood such as Cobb County public meetings.

There are currently six web pages linked from the home page menu – **Classifieds, Citizen Awareness Program, Committees, Documents, Amenities, and Contacts** which are defined below:

- **Classifieds:** Services can be offered or requested via the Classified Ads page such as baby sitting or fund raisers or commercial services such as landscaping. Unwanted items could be offered for sale or a wanted section for those looking for a particular item. Homes could even be advertised.
- **Citizen Awareness Program (Neighborhood Watch):** This page is currently under development but will eventually provide important information on Cobb County’s Citizen Awareness Program and how we get involved as neighbors to keep this a safe neighborhood for our children and ourselves. Stay tuned!
- **Committees:** Information on the various committees of the home owners association showing the names and contact information for those on each committee and the committee’s function.
- **Documents:** An archive of all documents pertaining to our home owners association including the legal documents, letters from the board, budget reports, forms, etc. All documents that are linked from the Documents web page are text searchable so you don’t have to read thru the whole document looking for a key word or phrase. Let’s say you wanted to find the keyword “owner” in the covenants document. You would find that the variations of the word “owner” occur in 155 places. The variations found of the word “owner” are “owners”, “ownership”, and “homeowners”. Try to use the simplest form of a word to find the most results. If we had used “own” instead of “owner” we would come up with 188 hits
- **Amenities:** Contains links to the rules regarding the use of the community pool and lake. The pool access code will never be published on the website since the website is visible by the whole world and publishing the lock code would defeat the purpose of having a code in the first place. This page is also where you would find information on any neighborhood organizations such as a tennis club or other amenities activities such as swimming lessons.
- **Contacts:** Names and contact information can be found on the contacts page for the board members and others associated with the home owners association such as the webmaster.

Remember, this is your website. To make it the most useful to our community I will be relying heavily on input from not just the board of directors but from all home owners!
